### McCurtain County claims July's highest county unemployment rate

In July 2010, **McCurtain County** reported Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 11.2 percent. **Latimer County** posted the state's second highest rate, and **Hughes County** recorded the month's third highest county rate. **Beaver County** held the state's lowest county rate again at 3.6 percent for the month. **Harper** and **Murray** counties rounded out the three lowest county rates in July 2010.


