OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - August 2010

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

McCurtain County posts August's highest county unemployment rate

In August 2010, **McCurtain County** once again claimed Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 11.2 percent. **Latimer County** posted the state's second highest rate, and **Sequoyah County** reported the month's third highest county rate. **Beaver County** held the state's lowest county rate again at 3.3 percent for the month. **Harper** and **Roger Mills** counties rounded out the three lowest county rates for August 2010.


