OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - September 2011 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Latimer County unemployment rate the state's highest in September

Latimer County posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 9.8 percent in September 2011. LeFlore County claimed the state's second highest county rate, while Okmulgee and Sequoyah counties shared the third highest monthly rate. Roger Mills County reported Oklahoma's lowest county rate. In September, 73 of Oklahoma's 77 counties reported unemployment rates increases over the month.


