Unemployment rates up in many counties for October

In October, **McCurtain County** claimed Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate at 10.2 percent. **Hughes and Latimer counties** tied for the second highest rate, and **LeFlore, Okmulgee and Sequoyah counties** shared the third highest rate. **Beaver County** reported the state's lowest county rate for the month.


