

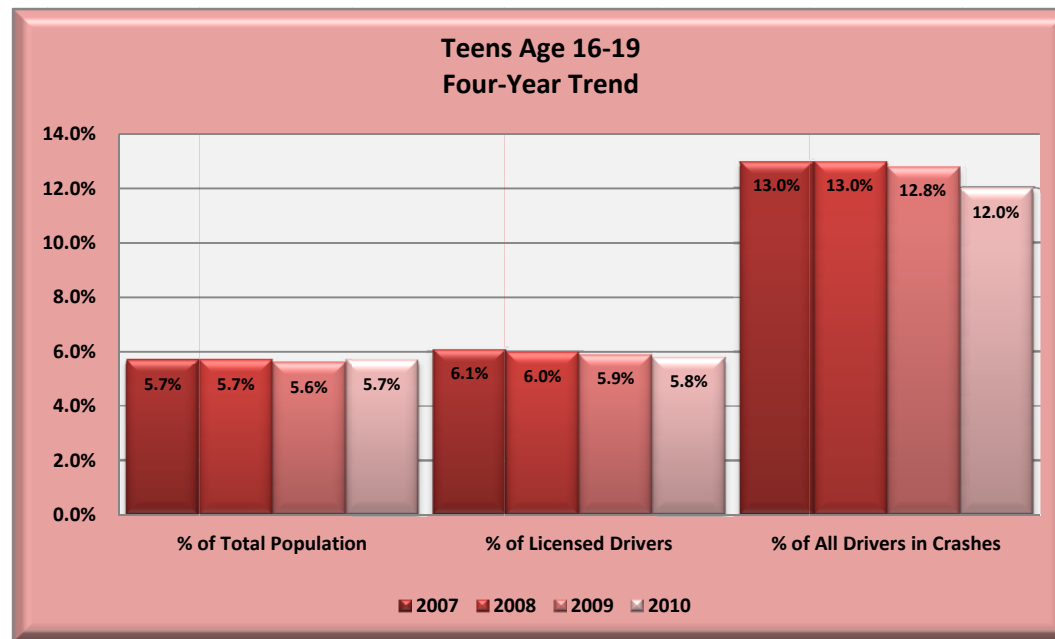
Teen Drivers Age 16-19 in Crashes (2010)

Alcohol-Related Driver Condition

Highway Safety Fact Sheet

Demographics

As shown in the chart below, in 2010 teens represented 5.7% of Oklahoma's total population, 5.8% of the total licensed drivers and 12.0% of all drivers involved in crashes. The percentage of teen drivers with an alcohol-related driver condition decreased 47.8% from 563 in 2009 to 294 in 2010.



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The percentage of teen drivers with an alcohol-related driver condition involved in crashes decreased 47.8% from 2009 to 2010

Driver Age & Sex

In 2010, a total of 294 drivers age 16-19 involved in crashes also had an alcohol-related driver condition. As shown in the table to the right, as driver age increased, involvement in crashes while drinking also increased.

Of the drinking drivers age 16-19 involved in crashes, 44.6% were age 19, 34.7% were age 18, 15.0% were age 17 and 5.8% were age 16.

Some 69.0% of the drivers age 16-19 with an alcohol-related driver condition were male.

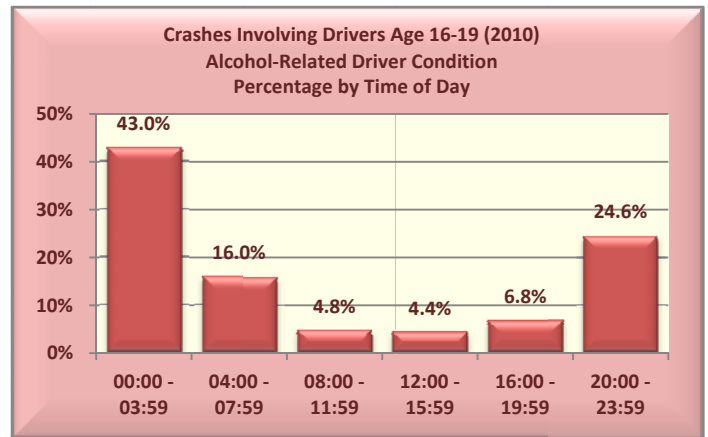
Seat Belt Use by Driver Fatalities

Seven driver fatalities age 16-19 who were also drinking were occupants of a passenger vehicle or pickup truck. Of these seven drivers, five were unrestrained.

Time & Day

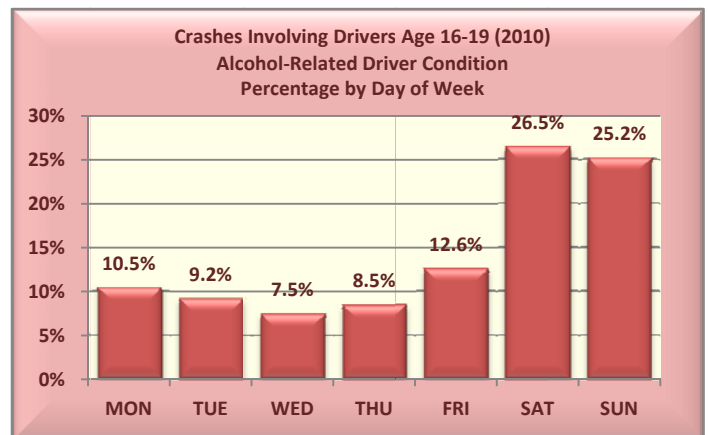
Some 43.0% of the crashes involving a drinking driver age 16-19 occurred between midnight (00:00) and 3:59 a.m. (03:59).

More crashes involving drinking drivers age 16-19 occurred on Saturday or Sunday than any other day of the week.

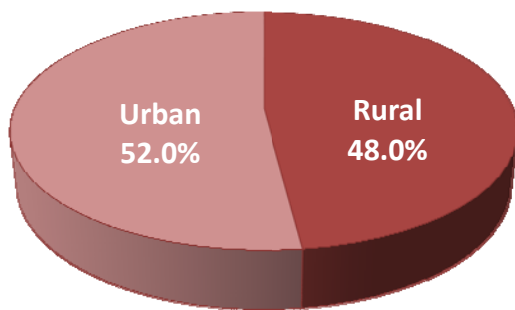


Rural vs. Urban
