

- ▶ Fatalities decreased from 12 in 2013 to eight in 2014.
- ▶ Alcohol/drug-related fatalities increased from three in 2013 to four in 2014.



Crashes & Fatalities

The 2014 Labor Day Holiday was a total of 78 hours, which began at 6 p.m. on Friday, August 29 and ended at midnight on Monday, September 1. During this time period, eight persons were killed in seven fatal crashes. Four of the eight fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.



Restraint Use Among Fatalities

Two driver fatalities in pickup trucks were unrestrained.
