

Crashes & Fatalities

The 2014 Memorial Day Holiday was a total of 78 hours which began at 6 p.m. on Friday, May 23 and ended at midnight on Monday, May 26. During this time period, 11 persons were killed in 10 fatal crashes. Five of the 11 fatalities occurred in alcohol/drug-related crashes.

Five fatalities were occupants of a passenger vehicle, three were occupants of a pickup truck, one was a single unit truck, one was a motorcyclist and one was an ATV operator.

Of the eight occupants of a passenger vehicle/pickup truck, four were unrestrained. Both the motorcyclist and ATV operator were not wearing a helmet.
