- Oklahoma crash reports are completed by law enforcement officers at the scene of a crash and show when a driver is distracted by an electronic device, largely based on self-reporting.
- The two choices officers have for indicating distraction by electronic devices are:
 - Electronic communications device (cell phone, pager, etc.)
 - Other electronic device (navigation device, Palm Pilot, etc.)
- In 2011, 13 fatal crashes, 707 injury crashes and 998 non-injury crashes involved a driver distracted by an electronic device.
- In 2012, 10 fatal crashes, 717 injury crashes and 996 non-injury crashes involved a driver distracted by an electronic device.
- In 2013, 14 fatal crashes, 602 injury crashes and 1,028 non-injury crashes involved a driver distracted by an electronic device.
- In 2014, 14 fatal crashes, 637 injury crashes and 1,043 non-injury crashes involved a driver distracted by an electronic device.
- In 2015, 11 fatal crashes, 694 injury crashes and 1,020 non-injury crashes involved a driver distracted by an electronic device.
