**SUMMARY:**

365:10-1-8 is revoked because it is based on statutory language which is no longer in effect.

365:10-1-17 is a new proposed rule that would specify the procedures for submitting life, accident, and health form filings to the Oklahoma Insurance Department. The rule requires form filings to be made through the System for Electronic Rate and Form Filing (SERFF) pursuant to the SERFF General Instructions. These rules are based on the requirements for property and casualty form filings.

365:10-31-6 and 7 are amended to align with new law passed in 2015, which prohibits the transmittal of reports from navigators and navigator entities which contain personally identifiable information.
