**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

ON THE 28<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2007 the above numbered and entitled cause came on for hearing and was concluded on the same date. The Insurance Commissioner, Kim Holland, was represented by her attorney, Sandra G. LaVenue. Respondent Allegheny Casualty Company's representative, Jerry Dowell was present and was represented by counsel, Kristen Hartman after having been mailed a copy of the Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause by certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known address as provided by Respondent to the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§1301-1340, and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, OKLA. STAT. tit. 75, §§250-323. Respondent Richard Chesney failed to appear in person, after having been mailed a copy of the Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause by certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known address as provided by Respondent to the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§1301-1340, and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, OKLA. STAT. tit. 75, §§250-323.

The Hearing Examiner, having been fully advised in the premises, finds by clear and convincing evidence as follows:

### **JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY**

1. That the Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction of this cause, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§1301-1340.
2. Respondent Allegheny Casualty Company is a licensed surety in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 0162.
3. Respondent Richard Chesney was a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 800710/200209. Having failed to renew his license by September 30, 2006, his license expired on October 1, 2006.

### **FINDINGSS OF FACT**

1. That on or about October 5, 2006, Petitioner, through her attorney, caused to be mailed a *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* to Respondents at their addresses of record.
2. That the *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* each contained statements of jurisdiction, allegations of fact, alleged violations of law and an order setting each the proceedings for November 1, 2006, at 9:30 a.m. at the office of the Insurance Commissioner, 2401 N.W. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, Suite 28, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73107.
3. That the Insurance Commissioner appointed Leslie L. Conner, Jr. to hear the case as the independent Hearing Examiner and he entered these findings and conclusions.
4. This matter was originally scheduled for a hearing on November 1, 2006 at the offices of the Insurance Commissioner, 2401 NW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, Suite 28, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73107.

5. On or about November 6, 2006, this matter was continued to December 13, 2006.
6. On or about November 28, 2006, this matter was continued to February 15, 2007.
7. On or about February 27, 2007, this matter was continued to March 21, 2007.
8. On or about March 28, 2007, this matter was continued to May 16, 2007.
9. Don Jackson entered an appearance on February 20, 2007 for both Respondents.
10. On May 25, 2007, Petitioner dismissed without prejudice the matter as the bond forfeiture was exonerated on April 25, 2007.

11. Petitioner received new information regarding the exoneration issued by the Court on April 25, 2007. As a result, a new Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause was issued on September 10, 2007. This *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* each contained statements of jurisdiction, allegations of fact, alleged violations of law and an order setting each the proceedings for September 19, 2007, at 9:30 a.m. at the office of the Insurance Commissioner, 2401 N.W. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, Suite 28, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73107.

12. On or about September 26, 2007, this matter was continued to October 17, 2007.
13. On or about October 29, 2007, this matter was continued to November 28, 2007.
14. The Hearing was recorded electronically by employees of the Oklahoma Insurance Department. Neither party requested a full stenographic record of the proceedings.

15. Kristen Hartman stated to the Court that she no longer represented Respondent Richard Chesney. It was her understanding that Don Jackson withdrew his appearance on behalf of Respondent Richard Chesney. The Hearing Examiner acknowledged Don Jackson's withdrawal in a case heard earlier in 2007. As a result, Respondent Richard Chesney did not receive proper service.

16. The Hearing Examiner was informed that Respondent Richard Chesney did not renew his bail bond license by September 30, 2006. As a result, it expired on October 1, 2006.

17. The following exhibits were introduced and admitted without objection:

Exhibit 1: (1 page) Copy of Order Exonerating Bond filed in Oklahoma County Court in case number CM-04-2058/ State v. Gary Keith JR Rosser.

18. Both parties agreed to stipulate to the facts as stated in the September 10, 2007 Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause. The facts are as follows:

a. On or about April 6, 2006, an appearance bond was issued as follows:

Defendant:	Gary Rosser
Case Number:	CM-2004-2058
City/County:	Oklahoma County
Bondsman:	Richard Chesney
Insurer:	Allegheny Casualty Company
Power Number:	XC-953310
Bond Amount:	\$4,000.00

b. On or about June 19, 2006, the bond was forfeited and an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued.

c. The Defendant was not returned to custody within ninety (90) days nor was the forfeiture paid within ninety-one (91) days.

d. On or about April 25, 2007, the Court issued an Order Exonerating Bond. Said Order stated that the bond forfeiture was paid out of time on March 8, 2007. In addition, it stated "Bondsman waives all claims to a remitter for this payment." In addition, the bond is ordered exonerated.

19. The District Court's Order merely exonerated the bond and did not set aside or vacate the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture. As a result, the Order Exonerating Bond does not vacate the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture. Therefore, Respondent Allegheny Casualty Company failed to deposit cash or other valuable securities in the face amount of the bond with the Court Clerk ninety-one (91) days from receipt or mailing of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture from

the Court Clerk is a violation of OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1332.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. These proceedings were commenced in accordance with and conducted pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, OKLA. STAT. tit. 75, §§ 250-323, as amended, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§ 1301-1340 as amended.

2. The Commissioner has jurisdiction to conduct this hearing as the Respondents are licensed bail bondsmen pursuant to OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§ 1301-1340, as amended.

3. The Respondents were provided lawful service and adequate notice of the time and place of the hearing and was sufficiently advised of the allegations against him as required by OKLA. STAT. tit. 75, § 309, as amended and OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1311, as amended.

4. The Independent Hearing Examiner was properly and legally appointed pursuant to OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1311.1(B).

5. As a result of Don Jackson's withdrawal as counsel for Respondent Richard Chesney, Respondent Richard Chesney did not receive proper service.

6. The Order Exonerating the Bond does not vacate the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture. In addition, the bond forfeiture was untimely paid. As a result, Respondent Allegheny Casualty Company has violated OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1332(D) by failing to deposit cash or other valuable securities in the face amount of the bond with the Court Clerk ninety-one (91) days from receipt or mailing of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture from the Court Clerk.


**ORDER**


1. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent Allegheny Casualty Company is hereby **censured**.
