On June 3, 2013 Governor Mary Fallin expanded her Executive Order 2013-20 to include an additional 22 counties in Oklahoma as a result of severe weather that occurred over the period of May 28-29, 2013.

The Oklahoma Insurance Department is **NOT** expanding its Bulletin Life & Health No. 2013-01 and P&C-04 to address these additional counties.

The Department has seen firsthand the concern and responsiveness that insurers have shown for their Oklahoma consumers during these difficult times. We expect and will continue to monitor the response to insureds affected by the series of storms in Oklahoma as warranted by the carriers' obligations to their policyholders.

All provisions of the Bulletin Life & Health No. 2013-01 and P&C-04 remain in effect until the expiration of the Emergency Declaration by Governor Fallin.
