On June 3, 2013 Governor Mary Fallin expanded her Executive Order 2013-20 to include an additional 22 counties in Oklahoma as a result of severe weather that occurred over the period of May 28-29, 2013.

The Oklahoma Insurance Department is **NOT** expanding its Bulletin Life & Health No. 2013-01 and P&C-04 to address these additional counties. **Coverage for insureds in the counties affected from the storms occurring on May 19 to 20, 2013 shall continue under all insurance policies in effect immediately preceding and shall remain in effect until June 18, 2013, unless circumstances exist that warrant extension. Any extension would only be effective while the Governor's Executive Order 2013-20 (amended June 3, 2013) remains in effect.**

The Department has seen firsthand the concern and responsiveness that insurers have shown for their Oklahoma consumers during these difficult times. We expect and will continue to monitor the response to insureds affected by the series of storms in Oklahoma as warranted by the carriers' obligations to their policyholders.
