**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

ON THE 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2008, the above numbered and entitled cause came on for hearing and was concluded on the same date. The Insurance Commissioner, Kim Holland, was represented by her attorney, Sandra G. LaVenue. Respondent appeared in person and with counsel, Michael D. Denton, Jr., after having been mailed a copy of the Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause by certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known address as provided by Respondent to the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§1301-1340, and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, OKLA. STAT. tit. 75, §§250-323.

The Hearing Examiner, having been fully advised in the premises, finds by clear and convincing evidence as follows:

**JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY**

1. That the Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction of this cause, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§1301-1340.
2. Respondent is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 800617/199849.

## STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. That on or about January 14, 2008, Petitioner, through her attorney, caused to be mailed a *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* to Respondent at her last known address of record.

2. That the *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* each contained statements of jurisdiction, allegations of fact, alleged violations of law and an order setting each the proceedings for February 26, 2008, at 9:30 a.m. at the office of the Insurance Commissioner, 2401 N.W. 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, Suite 28, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73107.

3. That the Insurance Commissioner appointed Leamon Freeman to hear the case as the independent Hearing Examiner and he entered these findings and conclusions.

4. The Hearing was recorded electronically by employees of the Oklahoma Insurance Department. Neither party requested a full stenographic record of the proceedings.

5. Amos Farr, Investigator for the Oklahoma Insurance Department, Robert Noll, Director of the Oklahoma Insurance Department's Bail Bond Division, Katherine Williams, Denise Bowline-Kimrey, and Todd Kimrey were all sworn in and testified under oath.

6. The following exhibits were introduced and admitted without objection:

Petitioner's One (P-1): (4 pages) The July 5, 2007 complaint filed by Todd Kimrey.

7. Respondent demurred to the evidence. Said demur was overruled.

8. Ms. Katherine Williams testified to the fact that Respondent did not solicit any bail bond from her on the June 27, 2007.

9. As a result, Petitioner was unable to prove that Respondent solicited any type of bond from Ms. Williams on June 27, 2007 in front of the Craig County Jail. The bond which was written on Ms. Williams' father, was not discussed until the next day by other family members of

Ms. Williams. Therefore, no solicitation occurred on June 27, 2007 between the Respondent and Ms. Williams.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Respondent has not violated OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1310(A)(14), by soliciting a bond in or about any place where prisoners are confined, arraigned, or in custody.


**ORDER**

1. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner that this matter is dismissed.




