


Aside Bond Forfeitures and Exonerating Bonds in Tulsa County District Court Case CM-2007-450. The Order Setting Aside Bond Forfeitures and Exonerating Bonds was issued on January 17, 2008, which was three (3) days after entry of the Administrative Order in the above referenced action. Pursuant to 75 O.S. § 317, this Court may reopen or reconsider a final agency order upon presentation of newly available evidence.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that upon consideration of the new evidence presented to this Court within ten (10) days from the date of entry of the Administrative Order, the instructions for Petitioner to withdraw the bond amount from Respondent's certificate of deposit as well as the fine in the amount of Four Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$400.00), shall be vacated. Due to Respondent's failure to appear and that the Order Setting Aside Bond Forfeitures and Exonerating Bonds was not obtained prior to Hearing on December 19, 2007, the costs of Seventy-five and No/100 Dollars shall remain in full force and effect, Respondent shall pay all costs due herein within thirty (30) days from receipt of this Order. Respondent's failure to timely pay all costs will result in the suspension of Respondent's license and said license shall remain suspended until all costs are paid in full.
