CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Kim Holland, Insurance Commissioner, and the Respondent Laura Earley (hereinafter Respondent), and enter into this Consent Order.

JURISDICTION

1. That the Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction of this cause, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§ 1301-1340.
2. That Respondent was a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 800865/199490. However, she failed to renew her license by September 30, 2008 and as a result; her license expired on October 1, 2007.
3. That Respondent has been apprised of her rights including the right to a public hearing and has knowingly and freely waived said rights and enters into this Consent Order as a voluntary settlement to the issues and questions raised in the above captioned case.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. On or about July 30, 2007, an appearance bond was issued as follows:

DEFENDANT:	Vicki Treaster
CASE NUMBER:	CF-2007-5440
CITY/COUNTY:	Oklahoma County
BAIL BONDSMAN:	Jimmy Johnson
INSURER:	Laura Earley

POWER NUMBER: 3217
BOND AMOUNT: \$4,500.00

2. On or about September 25, 2007, the bond forfeiture was forfeited and an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued.

3. The Defendant was not returned to custody within ninety (90) days nor were the forfeitures paid within ninety-one (91) days.

4. Respondent failed to list the address of the professional bondsman on the appearance bond.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has violated OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1332(D) by failing to deposit cash or other valuable securities in the face amount of the bond with the Court Clerk ninety-one (91) days from receipt or mailing of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture from the Court Clerk.


ORDER AND CONSENT

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner and CONSENTED to by the Respondent that she shall be and hereby is fined in the amount of Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$500.00). The fine must be paid prior to Respondent attempting to reapply for licensure for a bail bond license or any license the Oklahoma Insurance Commissioner has the authority to issue.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner and CONSENTED to by the Respondent that the amount of the bond, Four Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$4,500.00) is to be withdrawn from Respondent's certificate of deposit (CD). Said amount is to be forwarded to the Oklahoma County Court Clerk's office for payment of the forfeiture in CF-2007-5440, State v. Vickie Treaster.




