

3. Respondent is unable to comply with OKLA. STAT. TIT. 36 § 6615 A in that Respondent will not submit its 2007 annual statement on or before February 29, 2008.

AGREED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to OKLA. STAT. TIT. 36 § 6615 A, "...[E]ach such association and insurer shall, annually on or before the last day of February, file with the Insurance Commissioner its annual statement in the form prescribed by the Commissioner showing all premiums or assessments received by it in connection with the issuance of service warranties in this state during the preceding calendar year and other relevant financial information as deemed necessary by the Commissioner, using accounting principles which will enable the Commissioner to ascertain whether the financial requirements set forth in Section 6607 of this title have been satisfied."

2. Pursuant to OKLA. STAT. TIT. 36 § 6615 B, the Commissioner may levy a fine of up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day for each day a service warranty association neglects to file the annual statement in the form and within the time provided by the Service Warranty Insurance Act.


3. Pursuant to OKLA. STAT. TIT. 36 § 6610 D, the Commissioner may suspend or revoke the insurer's certificate of authority in this state for violation of the Service Warranty Insurance Act.

ORDER AND CONSENT

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner and CONSENTED to by the Respondent that Respondent accepts a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for failing to submit its annual statement on or before the last day of February, 2007. Further, Respondent agrees to submit its annual statement on or before May 1, 2008. If Respondent's annual

statement is not received on or before May 1, 2008, Respondent will be assessed an additional fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day commencing May 1, 2008 until said annual statement is received by the Oklahoma Insurance Department. Further, if Respondent's annual statement is not received on or before May 1, 2008, Respondent's certificate of authority will be suspended until said annual statement is received by the Oklahoma Insurance Department and the fine is paid.
