**CONSENT ORDER**

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Kim Holland, Insurance Commissioner, and the Respondent Seneca Insurance Company (hereinafter Respondent), and enter into this Consent Order.

**JURISDICTION**

1. That the Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction of this cause, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§ 1301-1340.
2. That Respondent is a licensed surety in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 2344.
3. That Respondent has been apprised of its rights including the right to a public hearing and has knowingly and freely waived said rights and enters into this Consent Order as a voluntary settlement to the issues and questions raised in the above captioned case.

**STIPULATIONS OF FACT**

1. On or about June 16, 2007, an appearance bond was issued as follows:

INSURER:	Seneca Insurance Company

2. On or about November 20, 2007, the bond was forfeited and an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued.

3. The Defendant was not returned to custody within ninety (90) days nor was the forfeiture paid within ninety-one (91) days.

4. That immediately upon notification from Petitioner, the Respondent paid the forfeiture.

5. The forfeiture was untimely paid on April 28, 2008.


### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has violated OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1332(D) by failing to deposit cash or other valuable securities in the face amount of the bond with the Court Clerk ninety-one (91) days from receipt or mailing of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture from the Court Clerk.

### ORDER AND CONSENT

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner and CONSENTED to by the Respondent that it shall be and hereby is fined in the amount of One Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00). The fine is to be paid immediately.


