

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. On or about May 16, 2008, Petitioner, through her attorney, caused to be mailed a *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* to Respondent at her last known address of record in Case Number 08-0635-DIS, setting the matter for hearing on June 18, 2008.

2. The *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* contained statements of jurisdiction, allegations of fact, and alleged violations of law.

4. The Insurance Commissioner appointed Leamon Freeman to hear the case as the independent Hearing Examiner in Case Number 08-0398-DIS.

5. The Insurance Commissioner appointed Leslie L. Conner, Jr. to hear the case as the independent Hearing Examiner in Case Number 08-0635-DIS.

6. On or about June 4, 2008, Respondent appeared with counsel in Case Number 08-0398-DIS and requested the matter be continued. The matter was continued to July 9, 2008, at 9:30 o'clock a.m. at the office of the Insurance Commissioner, 2401 N.W. 23rd Street, Suite, 28, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73107.

8. Respondent appeared and was represented by counsel, Thomas Hosty, on June 18, 2008 in Case Number 08-0635-DIS.

7. Respondent requested that case number 08-0398-DIS be heard with 08-0635-DIS by Leslie L. Conner, Jr. In addition, Respondent agreed to waive notice required by the Administrative Procedures Act, regarding 08-0398-DIS. Petitioner did not object to this request. Said request was granted.

8. Respondent verbally requested 08-0398-DIS and 08-0635-DIS be consolidated under 08-0635-DIS for hearing purposes. The Petitioner did not object to

the request. Cases 08-0398-DIS and 08-0635-DIS were hereby consolidated under Case Number 08-0635-DIS.

9. Both parties agree to stipulate to the following:

On or about September 29, 2007, an appearance bond was issued as follows:

On or about November 29, 2007, the bond was forfeited and an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued.

That the Oklahoma County District Court Clerk's office issued an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture and forwarded that Order to Petitioner with the instructions to proceed pursuant to the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act.

While the forfeiture was paid out of time, Respondent did pay the forfeiture on June 12, 2008.

On or about May 29, 2007, an appearance bond was issued as follows:

Case Number:	C414272, C414270, & C414271
City/County:	Midwest City Municipal
Bondsman:	Rhonda Wolf
Insurer:	Rhonda Wolf
Power Number:	N/A
Bond Amount:	\$947.00

On or about October 22, 2007, the bond was forfeited and an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued.

That the Midwest City Municipal Court Clerk's office issued an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture and forwarded that Order to Petitioner with the instructions to proceed pursuant to the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act.

While the forfeiture was paid out of time, Respondent did pay the forfeiture on June 12, 2008.

10. Respondent was sworn by the Hearing Examiner as a witness and testified as to the stipulation and that she had previously had problems with in running her bail bond business but has since hired counsel to assist her in complying with the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. These proceedings were commenced in accordance with and conducted pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, OKLA. STAT. tit. 75, §§ 250-323, as amended, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§ 1301-1340 as amended.

2. The Commissioner has jurisdiction to conduct this hearing as the Respondent is a licensed bail bondsmen pursuant to OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §§ 1301-1340, as amended.

3. The Independent Hearing Examiner was properly and legally appointed pursuant to OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, § 1311.1(B).

4. Respondent has violated OKLA. STAT. tit. 59, §1332(D) by failing to return the defendants to the appropriate Court within ninety (90) days or pay the forfeitures within ninety-one days of the issuance of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture.

ORDER

1. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER that Respondent is hereby fined in the amount of **One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00)** for the forfeiture issued by the Oklahoma County District Court, in Case

Number CM-2007-3650. In addition, Respondent is assessed costs in the amount of **Seventy-five and No/100 Dollars (\$75.00)**.

2. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER that Respondent is hereby fined in the amount of **One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00)** for the forfeiture issued by the Midwest City Municipal Court, in Case Number C414272, C414270, and C414271. In addition, Respondent is assessed costs in the amount of **Seventy-five and No/100 Dollars (\$75.00)**.

3. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER that the fine and costs are to be paid immediately.
