**CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD**

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Kim Holland, Insurance Commissioner, by and through her attorney, Julie Delluomo, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY

1. Kim Holland is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq.
2. Respondent is licensed by the State of Oklahoma as a resident insurance producer holding license number 78602.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On April 2, 2008 the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) received a request for assistance from Loyd Peavey to investigate a disputed balance allegedly owed to Farmers Insurance after Mr. Peavey cancelled his insurance with Farmers and moved his coverage to another insurer.
2. Analyst April Morris in the Consumer Assistance/Claims Division of the Department sent a copy of Mr. Peavey’s complaint along with a letter to Farmers agent Ron C. Wallace on April 3, 2008, requiring an adequate response pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1250.4(B).

3. The letter was sent to Ron C. Wallace's address of record with the Oklahoma Insurance Department: 1624 Greenbriar Pl. #300, Oklahoma City, OK 73159. A similar letter was sent to Farmers Insurance Company on the same date requiring an adequate response pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1250.4(B).

4. On April 15, 2008 the Department received a response from Eric Burtis with Farmers Insurance Company explaining the reason why Mr. Peavey's account with Farmers Insurance was still outstanding.

5. The letter sent to Ron C. Wallace on April 3, 2008 was returned on May 21, 2008 marked "Not at this Address." A call to Respondent's telephone number of record informed the Department that Respondent moved from the address on record approximately two years previous and that Respondent's new address was 3737 SW 119th, Suite D, Oklahoma City, OK 73170.

6. *Licensees shall inform the Insurance Commissioner by any means acceptable to the Insurance Commissioner of a change of address within thirty (30) days of the change. Failure to timely inform the Insurance Commissioner of a change in legal name or address shall result in penalty pursuant to Section 1435.13. 36 O.S. § 1435.8(F).*

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has violated 36 O.S. § 1435.8 by failing to inform the Insurance Commissioner of his change of address within thirty (30) days of the change.

2. Failure to timely inform the Insurance Commissioner of a change of address shall result in penalty pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner, subject to the following paragraph, that the Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 1435.8 and 36 O.S. § 1435.13 and therefore **Respondent is CENSURED AND FINED in the amount of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) payable within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the

Allegations of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing of this Order. Such request for hearing, if desired, shall be made in writing, addressed to Julie Delluomo, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, Post Office Box 53408, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73152-3408 and must be served on the Oklahoma Insurance Department within the thirty (30) days allotted. The proceedings on any such requested hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 et seq.
