DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY AND ORDER

COMES NOW on this 8th day of August, 2008, the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Kim Holland, Insurance Commissioner, and issues this order based upon the following findings and conclusions of law, to-wit:

JURISDICTION

1. That Kim Holland is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7004.
2. That, pursuant to Section 6218 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, in the event of a catastrophe, the Insurance Commissioner may declare an emergency to exist, and in the event of such a declaration, the Commissioner may issue a license as an emergency adjuster to any resident or nonresident applicant.

FINDINGS OF FACT

That on April 9 of the year 2009, wildfires caused widespread damage in the State of Oklahoma to homes and property resulting in a catastrophe in this state, and there is a likelihood that additional wildfires may occur over the days following April 9, 2009.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That, pursuant to Section 6218 of Title 36, in the event of a catastrophe, the Insurance Commissioner may declare an emergency to exist, and in the event of such a

declaration, the Commissioner may issue a license as an emergency adjuster to any resident or nonresident applicant.

2. That, pursuant to Section 6218 of Title 36, an individual licensed as an emergency adjuster pursuant to Section 6128 may only adjust claims related to the catastrophe.

3. That, pursuant to Section 6218 of Title 36, a license as an emergency adjuster shall remain in force for not more than ninety (90) days from the date of issue, unless extended for an additional ninety (90) days by the Commissioner.

4. That, pursuant to Section 6218 of Title 36, the Insurance Commissioner should declare that an emergency exists.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE DECLARED AND ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner that an emergency exists in the State of Oklahoma due to a catastrophe caused by wildfires.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that licenses shall be issued to emergency adjusters pursuant to Section 6218 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Insurance Code to adjust losses occurring as a result of wildfires occurring from April 9 of the year 2009 to April 11, 2009.




