

To: NON RESIDENT ADJUSTERS

RE: CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWALS

DATE: SEPTEMBER 15, 2006

As part of an ongoing effort by the Oklahoma Insurance Department to establish uniformity and equity in all resident and non-resident Continuing Education requirements and processes, the following change is being made. As of September 15th, 2006, the Oklahoma Insurance Department will accept proof of Continuing Education requirements in any of the following three manners:

1. Any Non-Resident Oklahoma Adjuster who resides in a State requiring Licensing and Continuing Education credits may provide a Letter of Certification from their home state in order to satisfy the State of Oklahoma's Continuing Education Requirements.
2. Any Non-Resident Oklahoma Adjuster who does not reside in a State requiring Licensing and Continuing Education may provide a Letter of Certification from another state in which they hold a valid Adjusters license that **does require** Licensing and Continued Education credits in order to satisfy the State of Oklahoma's Continuing Education Requirements.
3. Any Non-Resident Oklahoma Adjuster may provide proof of Continuing Education from any provider approved by the State of Oklahoma in order to satisfy the State of Oklahoma's Continuing Education Requirements.
