A rulemaking hearing of the Oklahoma Insurance Department will be held March 18, 2011, at 9:30 a.m. in the Public Conference Room of the Offices of Insurance Commissioner John Doak at 3625 N.W. 56th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to hear public comment on proposed permanent rulemaking. The proposed amendments that are the subject of this public hearing are to the following Insurance Department rules:

2. Chapter 10, Life, Accident and Health, Sections 365:10-1-6, 13, 15; Sections 365:10-5-4, 128.2, 134, and Appendix S (File No. 11-0067-RUL);
3. Chapter 15, Property and Casualty, Sections 365:15-1-3, Sections 365:15-3-5 Sections 365:15-7-17 and 32 (File No. 11-0068-RUL);
4. Chapter 25, Licensure of Producers, Adjusters, Bail Bondsmen, Companies, Prepaid Funeral Benefits, Cemetery Merchandise Trusts, and Viatical Settlements Providers and Brokers, Sections 365: 25-3-1, 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20.1, 20.2, 20.3; Sections 365: 25-5-3; Sections 365: 25-5-35, 41, 45, and 46; Sections 365: 25-23-1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and Appendix T (File No. 11-0069- RUL).
