ORDER DENYING MOTION TO STAY

On the 4th day of November, 2011, Respondent, Aaron A. Scott ("Scott") filed a Motion to Stay ("Motion") with the Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board (the "Board"). The Motion requests a Stay of the Board's Order #11-020 until a final decision is made by the District Court in which his Petition for Judicial Review was filed on September 2, 2011.

On the 29th day of November, 2011, the Board's prosecutor filed his Objection to Aaron Scott's Motion to Stay ("Objection"). The Objection centers on Scott's failure to ask for a stay of the Board's original Order on August 5, 2011, at which Board meeting Scott was present; as well as the fact that Scott did not request a Stay from the District Court at the time he filed his Petition for Appeal and Review of Board's Decision.

The Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board has jurisdiction of this cause, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Certified Real Estate Appraisers Act, 59 O.S. § 858-700 *et seq.*

The Board, being fully advised in the matter, including hearing oral argument from Vic Albert, counsel for Respondent, Scott, and the Board's prosecutor, Stephen L. McCaleb, HEREBY DENIES Respondent's Motion to Stay; and FURTHER ORDERS that a two month extension be granted in which the \$1,000 fine ordered paid under Board Order #11-020 shall be due. The two month extension shall begin from the original deadline of December 8, 2011. Said fine will now be due on or before February 8, 2012.
