<p>Shot of tennis court. Wife at far end preparing to serve. From behind, we see husband from neck up. Camera pans down to show way too tight shirt and shorts and him reaching back to adjust shorts.</p> <p>Cut to bathroom — wife, at mirror, wearing cocktail dress, putting on earrings, is smiling. Husband walks in wearing a sweat suit. He looks at his wife and gives kind of an "oops" face.</p> <p>Cut to direct shot of woman sitting holding a phone, looking concerned, from torso up. (Looking at camera)</p> <p>Cut to wide shot showing man sitting in front of plexiglass — (he's a tatted up, crazy looking prisoner.) (Looking at camera)</p> <p>Cut to patient (older man) in patient examination room.
