what is Medicare?

Medicare is the federal health insurance program available to all people at age 65. It is also available to people under age 65 with certain disabilities. People of any age who have end-stage renal disease or Lou Gehrig's (ALS) can qualify, as well.

Medicare is made up of four parts:

Medicare Part A covers:

- Inpatient Hospital
- Skilled Nursing Facility
- Home Health Care
- Hospice

Medicare Part B covers:

- Doctors Services
- Outpatient Hospital & Emergency Room
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Other Services & Supplies

Medicare Advantage Plans (Medicare Part C):

You may elect a Medicare Advantage option if you are entitled to Part A and enrolled in Part B of Medicare, you do not have end stage renal disease, and you live in a geographic area served by the option.

The Medicare Advantage options include:

- Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)
- Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs)
- Private Fee for Service (PFFS) Plans
