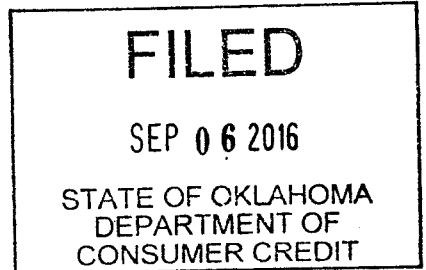

**CONSENT ORDER**

The Petitioner, State of Oklahoma, ex rel., Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and the Respondent, ASSENT INC., ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. The Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

- (1) The Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.
  - i. The licensing system of record for mortgage brokers, mortgage lenders and mortgage loan originators in the State of Oklahoma is NMLS.
  - ii. The Respondent is an active foreign for profit business corporation company in the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 2312474169.
  - iii. The Respondent is licensed as a mortgage broker in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to the SAFE Act with the following licensing information indicated by NMLS:
    - a. Oklahoma license number MB010432.

b. NMLS unique identifier number/company ID 818108.

c. Mailing address of record at 18881 Von Karmon, Unit #1075, Irvine, CA 92612.

- iv. On January 20, 2016, Petitioner e-mailed Respondent the original invoice for examination fees to be reimbursed by Respondent. Email: mkazemi@assent123.com.
- v. On May 17, 2016, Petitioner mailed the invoice for examination fees, via certified mail, which was signed for and received at 18881 Von Karmon, Unit #1075, Irvine, CA 92612 on May 20, 2016.
- vi. As of August 17, 2016, Respondent has failed to pay \$500.00 in examination reimbursement fees.

(2) The Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order.

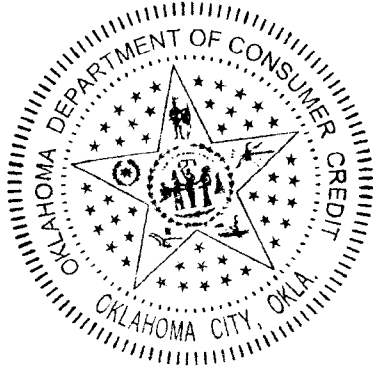
(3) The Respondent agrees to pay the late fees of \$500.00 and a \$500.00 civil penalty, for a total of \$1,000.00, payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before September 26, 2016.

(4) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 16-0135-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of Roy John Martin, General Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 3613 N.W. 56<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 240, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to the Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County,

Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).

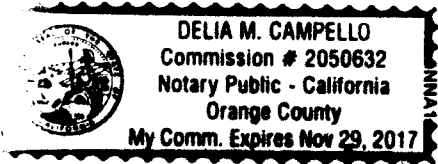
