CONSENT ORDER

The Petitioner, State of Oklahoma, ex rel., Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and the Respondent, Lawton Gold & Silver Exchange, LLC, ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. The Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

- (1) The Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter.
 - i. The Respondent is registered as a domestic limited liability company in the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 35122361423, active filing status.
 - ii. The Respondent is a licensed precious metal and gem dealer; license number PM007514, and transacts business at 1919 W. Gore Blvd., #3, Lawton, OK 73502.
 - iii. On September 21, 2016, Consumer Credit Examiner, Viola Peters, visited the Respondent's business location at 1919 W. Gore Blvd., #3, Lawton, OK 73502, to conduct an inspection of the Respondent's precious metal and gem transactions.
 - iv. The Report of Inspection issued by the

Petitioner, dated September 21, 2016, attached and incorporated by reference herein, states that the Respondent failed to list adequate descriptions of the items involved or the ticket was missing in twenty-five (25) transactions.

- v. The Report of Inspection states that the Respondent does support descriptions with pictures in most transactions, but the Examiner found that some tickets did not have correlating pictures to match some items in eleven (11) transactions.
- vi. The Report of Inspection also states that the Respondent did not list on one (1) ticket the amount of money involved in the transaction.
- (2) The Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order.
- (3) The Respondent agrees to pay a \$200.00 civil penalty, payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before January 9, 2017.
- (4) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number $16-0183-\mathrm{DIS}$ and shall be addressed to the attention of Roy John Martin, General Counsel, Department of Consumer Credit, 3613 N.W. 56^{th} Street, Suite 240, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112.
- (5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to the Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.
- (6) If the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 1528(A).
