## CONSENT ORDER

Petitioner, State of Oklahoma ex rel. Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and Respondent, Four Star Fitness Guthrie Inc., d/b/a Four Star Fitness, ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of this individual proceeding to avoid litigation. Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

- (1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by Petitioner in the Notice and Order of Hearing filed in this matter.
  - i. Respondent is a domestic for profit business corporation under the jurisdiction of the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 1913276159, active filing status.
  - ii. Respondent transacts business at 1515 S. Division St., Guthrie, OK 73044.
  - iii. On June 12, 2023, Jimmie Ray and Michael Thompson, Consumer Credit Investigators, went to Respondent's business premises and spoke to Destiny, Respondent's representative. Destiny advised that Respondent had been operating at this location since March of 2023. Destiny advised members can sign up for month-to-month memberships or 12-month packages. The investigators requested to scan member contracts and pricing sheet.

- iv. As of the date of the Notice, Respondent did not have a Health Spa license for this location.
- (2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by the Petitioner in the Notice and Order of Hearing filed in this matter, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.
- (3) Respondent agrees to apply for a Health Spa License with Petitioner and pay the license fees associated with the Health Spa License.
- (4) Respondent agrees to pay a \$250.00 civil penalty, payable to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, on or before July 27, 2023.
- (5) The payment shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 23-0013-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Attorney, Department of Consumer Credit, 629 NE 28th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105.
- (6) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned by United States mail to Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.
- (7) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 2095.17(c).


