CONSENT ORDER

Petitioner, State of Oklahoma *ex rel.* Department of Consumer Credit ("Petitioner") and Respondent, Par Management LLC, d/b/a Sandy Beaches Sun Spa, ("Respondent") voluntarily enter into this Consent Order as an informal disposition of these individual proceedings to avoid litigation. Respondent agrees to waive its right to a hearing under the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act and both parties agree as follows:

(1) Petitioner restates and incorporates by reference the allegations made by Petitioner in the Notices of Hearing filed in these matters.

a. Respondent is a domestic limited liability company under the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma Secretary of State filing number 3512042330, active filing status.

b. Respondent transacts business at the following locations:

- (v) 2627 Classen Blvd., Ste. 128, Norman, OK 73071
- (vi) 3700 W. Robinson, Ste. 128, Norman, OK 73072
- (vii) 15200 N. Western Ave., Edmond, OK 73013
- (viii) 5501 Main St., Ste. 108, Del City, OK 73115

- c. On February 14, 2018, Jimmie Ray and Michael Thompson, consumer credit investigators, went to Respondent's business locations to conduct an investigation.
- d. The investigators took exterior photos of the locations. Respondent advertises on their web page a 3-month contract commitment and membership prices. The investigators spoke to Respondent's General Manager, Brittany Byers, via telephone and requested copies of member contracts. Ms. Byers emailed the investigators a sample of members' contracts and a screen shot of payment histories for a sample of active members. The contracts show a 3-month commitment.
- e. Respondent has engaged or offered to engage in making consumer credit sales.
- f. Respondent is not a supervised financial organization or a person holding a license to make supervised loans issued under 14A O.S. § 3-501 et seq.
- g. As of the date of the Notices, Respondent is not licensed at any locations in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to the provisions of 14A O.S. §§ 6-201 through 6-203 of the UCCC. 14A O.S. § 6-203(2).
- h. Respondent did not file notification pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-202 of the UCCC, on or before January 31, 2018.
- i. Respondent has failed to pay the notification license filing fee of \$120.00 for each business location pursuant to OKLA. ADMIN. CODE § 160:5-1-2(2)(A).

(2) Respondent does not admit to the allegations made by Petitioner in the Notices of Hearing filed in these matters, and incorporated by reference in this Consent Order, except that Respondent admits the facts necessary to establish the Department's jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this action.

(3) Respondent will submit a notification license application and pay all applicable registration/application fees to the Department for each location. In addition, Respondent

agrees to pay a \$3,500.00 civil penalty payable in seven (7) monthly installments of \$500.00 each with first payment due on or before March 1, 2019 and subsequent payments due on or before the 1st of the month for the next 6 months thereafter.

(4) The payments shall be made payable by check or money order to the Oklahoma Department of Consumer Credit, shall indicate the payment is for Case Number 18-220-DIS through 18-0227-DIS and shall be addressed to the attention of John T. Coyne, Chief Enforcement Attorney, Department of Consumer Credit, 3613 N.W. 56th Street, Suite 240, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112.

(5) A file stamped copy of this Consent Order will be returned to the Respondent upon signature of the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit or the Deputy Administrator of the Department Consumer Credit.

(6) If Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Administrator of the Department of Consumer Credit is authorized to file an application to enforce this Consent Order in the District Court of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma in accordance with the provisions of 14 O.S. § 6-113(4).

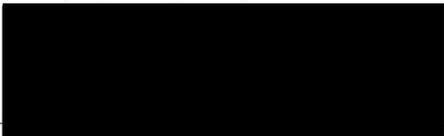
