Lindsey Flowers serves as the Music and Marketing Coordinator of the Oklahoma Film & Music Office (OF&MO). In that role, she oversees outreach and support of the state's music industry and works to populate the Oklahoma Music Guide by conducting regular outreach to artists and music businesses across the state. She manages music sponsorships, designs and oversees production of marketing materials, composes press releases, and maintains the office website, oklahomafilm.org, which includes an events page that highlights film and music events statewide. She also edits the weekly e-newsletter *This Week in Film and Music* that has circulation of over 2,600. In addition, she works with the Film Coordinator to manage the office internship program, maintain social media, and archive records of the Oklahoma Film & Music Office in the media.

A native to Oklahoma, Lindsey received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Visual Communications from the University of Oklahoma in 2005, and proceeded to become a Peace Corps volunteer, serving two years in Kenya teaching about Health, English, Art and Music in a school for the Blind and Deaf. Following that she moved to Tokyo, Japan where she was a teacher at an International Kindergarten and also helped facilitate music and art events for *Parties 4 Peace*, a non-profit organization there. Upon her return to Oklahoma, she found her passion for marketing and development while working at a non-profit organization that serves underemployed and homeless individuals in Oklahoma City.
