

AGREED ORDER

The parties herein, after commencement of the hearing, and after the noon break, announced to the Court they had agreed to the following terms:

1. Appellee will withdraw from Appellant's personnel file the five-day suspension based on the matters set forth in the proposed discipline notice of June 22, 2006, and will take no other disciplinary action on those matters. It is understood that this agreement will not affect Appellant's oral and written reprimands which are not at issue in this appeal.
2. Appellee will reimburse Appellant for five (5) days back pay and benefits.
3. Both parties will pay their own attorney fees.
4. Appellee will pay Appellant's discovery copying costs in the approximate amount of \$1,276.00.

These terms constitute the entire agreement between the parties.

As the parties have reached a settlement between themselves of the issues involved in the appeal, it is the finding of the Court that this matter should be and is hereby ORDERED DISMISSED.
