


ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This Appeal was filed by Appellant on March 19, 2010 following the issuance of a letter of reprimand from Appellee. Unable to resolve the matter through negotiation or mediation, the appeal was set for a hearing before this administrative law judge. A pre-trial conference was held November 23, 2010 and a trial scheduled. On March 9, 2011, Appellee filed a Petition for Declaratory Relief in the District Court of Oklahoma County, seeking to determine whether the Merit Protection Commission had jurisdiction in this matter, and an Order Staying Proceedings was issued by the undersigned pending outcome of the District Court case. The District Court case is still pending, however, according to Appellee, Appellant's employment was terminated effective August 24, 2010, his appeal of that termination has been denied, and the termination has become final.

On April 8, 2014 the undersigned issued an Order to Show Cause directing Appellant to indicate his interest in moving forward with this matter and a showing of good cause why this matter should not be dismissed. Appellant was directed to respond by April 21, 2014. As of this date, Appellant has failed to respond.

Accordingly, the instant case is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice in accordance with Merit Rule 455:10-3-13(a)(2).
