

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Pre-Hearing Conference in the instant case was set for 9:00 a.m., January 10, 2011 at the Merit Protection Commission offices in Oklahoma City, before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge. John Douglas, Assistant General Counsel, was present for Appellee. Appellant failed to appear either in person or by representative. No request for continuance has been filed. Appellant called the Commission offices just prior to the scheduled hearing and advised that he would not appear, on advice of his counsel. Appellee moved to dismiss this case. This Administrative Law Judge issued a show cause order directing Appellant to respond within ten days to show good cause why this appeal should not be dismissed. Appellant has failed to respond to the Order to Show Cause.
