



FINAL PETITION DECISION



Appellee requested reconsideration of the final order of the Administrative Law Judge sustaining the Appellant's appeal.

On September 24, 2015, Appellee's Request for Reconsideration of the Administrative Law Judge's Final Order was heard by the Commissioners. The Commissioners voted to deny the motion for reconsideration, but granted the Appellee's request for alternative relief regarding the issue of offset. The parties are given 10 days to meet and determine the amount of the offset. If the parties, in ten days, can not come to an agreement on the amount of the offset they are to notify Director Shelley at which time the case will be set for hearing in front of an Administrative Law Judge for a determination of the proper amount of the offset.
