

MINUTES OF A MEETING  
OF THE  
OKLAHOMA MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

*In conformity with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, advance notice of this regular meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 17, 2021. Public notice of this meeting, together with the agenda, was posted in prominent public view on the front door of the Northwest Office Center, 4334 NW Expressway, Oklahoma City, on February 7, 2022 prior to 10am, and, announcement of the Board meeting and agenda were posted on the OMVC website [www.omvc.ok.gov](http://www.omvc.ok.gov) on February 7, 2022 prior to 10am.*

The Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission met in Regular session at 10:00 am, on February 8, 2022. Secretary Eric Stuteville called the meeting to order. A roll call was held; members present were Jim Norton, Curtis Hayes, Jeromey Clayton, Megan Vance Ochs, and Eric Stuteville. Commissioners Carol Carver, Fred Malone, Fred Harlan and Ervin Randle were absent.

The Chair announced that there were enough members present to constitute a quorum. Also present were Brad Bailey, Executive Director, Marilyn Maxwell, Deputy Director, and Sandra Balzer, Assistant Attorney General.

Each Commission Member had received a copy of the **Minutes** of the January 18, 2022 Commission Meeting. Megan Vance Ochs made a motion, seconded by Curtis Hayes, to approve the Minutes as submitted. The Chair called for a roll call vote; votes were as follows:
