FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE OKLAHOMA STATE CHARITABLE CAMPAIGN?

The Oklahoma State Charitable Campaign (SCC) is an annual, unified fundraising effort that provides state employees with the opportunity to make donations to their favorite charitable organizations through the convenience of payroll deduction or one-time gifts. The SCC is governed by the Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable Contributions (OCSECC), which is comprised of seven state employee appointees.

HOW DO I GIVE?

During the annual campaign, all state employees have the opportunity to make charitable contributions via a provided pledge card. All donations, large or small, are welcomed and greatly appreciated. We encourage you to consider the many needs in your community and make the most generous gift possible. Through payroll deductions, employees may divide the annual contribution into smaller, regular amounts which are deducted each pay period during the coming calendar year. One dollar per pay period is the minimum deduction for payroll deductions. While payroll deduction is the preferred method, contributions may also be made by check or cash.

WHO CAN I GIVE TO?

This charity guide lists all of the eligible charitable federations and their member charities. Through the SCC you may designate your gift to federations or member charities by indicating choices on the pledge card. Each federation and charity is listed separately, with an assigned four-digit charity code (e.g. 1234) that must be used when making a selection to ensure that your contribution reaches the charity or charities you wish to support.

To support a federation and have your gift shared among all of its charities, choose the federation code as it appears preceding the federation name and description. To support an individual charity within a federation, select that charity's code as it appears preceding the charity name and description. Pledge cards returned with donations but without charity code numbers will be counted as undesignated donations.


WHAT HAPPENS TO THE UNDESIGNATED DONATIONS?

According to Oklahoma Statutes, undesignated money shall be distributed in the same proportion as designated dollars within the state of Oklahoma.

WHAT IS THE ADMINISTRATIVE RATE FOR THE SCC?

Administrative costs for the 2009 campaign were 10 percent of funds received. These funds provide for campaign materials creation and printing, postage and supplies, loaned executive support, coordinator training, campaign recognition and professional staff. All federations share in the administrative cost proportionate to their designations in the campaign.

YOUR DOLLARS MAKE AN IMPACT

\$1/week or \$52/year

Provides educational materials for 100 people diagnosed with lupus.

\$2/week or \$104/year

Provides a months' supply of seizure medication for an epilepsy patient.

\$1/week or \$52/year

Provides 14 glucose tests that screen for diabetes for low income women and children at Variety Care.

\$1/week or \$52/year

Provides a day of vocational training for an individual with a developmental disability so that he or she can develop good work skills and ability to attain his or her personal vocational goal, which is usually employment in the community and a sense of independence that comes from earning that paycheck.

Provides 26 nights of shelter and a hot meal for a homeless individual at the Salvation Army Emergency Shelter.

Provides a safe and positive experience at Boys and Girls Clubs of Oklahoma County for an inner-city youth after-school and throughout the summer.

Helps Mental Health Association screen teens for signs of depression and suicide.

Pays for one chart vision screening for a child at a Head Start by a trained screener trained by staff at Prevent Blindness Oklahoma.



At first glance, Colton looks like a typical one-year-old. He sways and toddles side to side almost falling over as he learns how to use his legs. But Colton is not one; he is a three year old boy who just learned how to walk.

Colton was born with mild hearing loss in his right ear, but gradually other problems began to occur. His left eyelid started to droop making it difficult for him to see, he doesn't know how to talk and is on medicine for high blood pressure.

Doctors are baffled by his health problems.

His mother has two other children to take care of as well as the bills from Colton's visits to the speech therapist, ear, nose and throat doctors, psychologist and eye surgeons. She turned to an SCC participating charity for help with every day necessities.

"When we come to (the SCC participating charity) for a second the burden of everything else is lifted off our shoulders," said Stacey, Colton's mom. "When I am here I am not worrying, I am not stressed, I am grateful."

Because of SCC donors like you, Stacy can spend thirty minutes at an SCC participating charity and forget about the bills, forget about the doctors and just be thankful for what she was receiving.

At six months, Shea Retherford was not gaining weight and was becoming lethargic so her doctors sent her to Children's Hospital in Oklahoma City, where after days of tests the doctors finally diagnosed her with Cystic Fibrosis (CF), a chronic genetic disease. Over the next three months, under the care of Dr. James Royall, Shea gained nearly ten pounds, more than she had gained in six months. At eight months she had to have a corneal transplant to save her eye. The transplant went well and she was gaining weight. In November 2002, she began having problems with her eye again and underwent another surgery to correct the problem. Shea does chest physical therapy two times a day with an ABI vest to keep her lungs clear, takes medications to keep her liver healthy and uses eye drops for her eye complications. Because of SCC donors, Shea is able to receive the care she needs to live a happy and healthy life.
