INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE STATE EMPLOYEE PLEDGE FORM

Please read the pledge form carefully before you complete it. Your form must be signed to authorize payroll deduction OR agency designations OR name release.

PAYROLL DEDUCTION:

If you choose payroll deduction, put a check mark in the box before the amount you wish deducted from your paycheck each month. Sign and date the pledge form. Keep the yellow copy for your records. Return the white, pink and green copies to your Campaign Coordinator.

CASH CONTRIBUTIONS:

If you are making a cash contribution, indicate the amount on the line provided and attach your check or cash, keep the yellow copy. Return the white, pink and green copies to your Campaign Coordinator.

AGENCY DESIGNATIONS:

If you want to direct your contribution to specific agencies (not more than two), write the code number for these agencies (you’ll find them listed inside the brochure) on the pledge form. Remember to indicate the amount in dollars each agency you choose is to receive, even if you are choosing only one agency to receive all of your contribution. Sign and date the pledge form. To authorize release of your name and address to the designated agency so that they can recognize your gift with a letter of acknowledgement, please provide that information at the bottom of the pledge card.
