EXECUTIVE ORDER 2000-14

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Oklahoma Statutes in 25 O.S. 1998, Section 82.1, hereby order the following dates be observed as holidays by the State of Oklahoma in 2001:

Monday	January 1	New Year's Day
Monday	January 15	Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday
Monday	February 19	Presidents' Day
Monday	May 28	Memorial Day
Wednesday	July 4	Independence Day
Monday	September 3	Labor Day
Monday	November 12	Veterans Day
Thursday & Friday	November 22 & 23	Thanksgiving
Monday & Tuesday	December 24 & 25	Christmas

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Office of Personnel Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
