Students in sixth through 12th grades are invited to participate in a "crime scene" investigation program set for 7-8:30 p.m., Tuesday, March 29th at the Edmond Public Library, 10 S. Boulevard.

Participants will learn how to safely process a crime scene and look for possible dangers during a program led by Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) criminalists.

Participating young criminalists will determine what evidence will be sampled, photographed, and analyzed. The participants will transfer the evidence by "pipetting" and then microscopically analyze samples and check for "pH".
