AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ADA, OKLAHOMA; AMENDING SECTION 18-52, ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, 2015 EDITION, INCLUDING APPENDICES, AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AMENDING SECTION 18-61, ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL EXISTING BUILDING CODE, 2015 EDITION, INCLUDING APPENDICES, AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AMENDING SECTION 18-71, ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 2014 EDITION, INCLUDING ANNEXES, AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AMENDING SECTION 18-156, ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, 2015 EDITION AND THE INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE, 2015 EDITION, AND APPENDICES, AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AMENDING SECTION 18-201, ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE, 2015 EDITION, INCLUDING APPENDICES, AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AMENDING SECTION 62-35, ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, 2015 EDITION, AS AMENDED AND MODIFIED BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA, AND THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION'S LIFE SAFETY CODE 101, 2015 EDITION; PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE FOR CODES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 18-52 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-52. Building code adopted.

The city hereby adopts the International Building Code, 2015 edition, including appendices, as amended and modified in Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 748: 20-1-1 to 748: 20-15-

16, at least one copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk. Such code shall be in full force and effect within the city to the same extent as if set forth in full in this section; provided, however, that in the event of a conflict between any provision of such code and any provision of the ordinances of the city, the latter shall govern. A violation of any provision of such code shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in Section 1-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 18-61 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-61. Existing building code adopted.

The city hereby adopts the International Existing Building Code, 2015 edition, including appendices, as published by the International Code Council, as amended and modified in Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 748: 20-1-1 to 748: 20-15-16, as and for the Existing Building Code of the City of Ada, regulating and governing the repair, alteration, change of occupancy, addition and relocation of existing buildings, including, but not limited to, historic buildings, as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Existing Building Code, at least one copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof. Such code shall be in full force and effect within the city to the same extent as if set forth in full in this section; provided, however, that in the event of a conflict between any provision of such code and any provision of the ordinances of the city, the latter shall govern. A violation of any provision of such code shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in Section 1-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 18-71 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-71. Electrical code adopted.

The city hereby adopts the National Electrical Code, 2014 edition, including annexes, as amended and modified in Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 748: 20-1-1 to 748: 20-15-16, at least one copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk. Such code shall be in full force and effect within the city to the same extent as if set forth in full in this section; provided, however, that in the event

of a conflict between any provision of such code and any provision of the ordinances of the city, the latter shall govern. A violation of any provision of such code shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in Section 1-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 18-156 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-156. Mechanical code and fuel gas code adopted.

The city hereby adopts the International Mechanical Code, 2015 edition, including appendices, and the International Fuel Gas Code, 2009 edition, including appendices, as amended and modified in Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 748: 20-1-1 to 748: 20-15-16, at least one copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk. Such code shall be in full force and effect within the city to the same extent as if set forth in full in this section; provided, however, that in the event of a conflict between any provision of such codes and any provision of the ordinances of the city, the latter shall govern. A violation of any provision of such codes shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in Section 1-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 18-201 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-201. Plumbing code adopted.

The city hereby adopts the International Plumbing Code, 2015 edition, including appendices, as amended and modified in Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 748: 20-1-1 to 748: 20-15-16, at least one copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk. Such code shall be in full force and effect within the city to the same extent as if set forth in full in this section; provided, however, that in the event of a conflict between any provision of such code and any provision of the ordinances of the city, the latter shall govern. A violation of any provision of such code shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in Section 1-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 62-35 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 62-35. Fire code and life safety code adopted.

The city hereby adopts the International Fire Code, 2015 edition, and the National Fire Protection Association's Life Safety Code 101, 2009 edition, including appendices at least one copy of each being on file in the office of the city clerk. Such codes shall be in full force and effect within the city to the same extent as if set forth in full in this section; provided, however, that in the event of a conflict of any provision of such codes and any provision of the ordinances of the city, the latter shall govern. A violation of any provision of such codes shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in Section 1-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ada.


SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall for any reason be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Ada that this section of the Ada Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and public good of the City of Ada and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this Ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage, as provided by law.

PASSED AND APPROVED and the emergency clause voted on separately this 16th day of February, 2016.
