In accordance with the administrative rules of the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission, Oklahoma Administrative Code Section 748:15-1-2, I, Patrick T. Boulden, City Attorney for the City of Bixby, Oklahoma, a municipal corporation, certify as follows:

1. I am the duly appointed and qualified City Attorney for the City of Bixby, Oklahoma and in that capacity I serve as legal counsel to the City of Bixby.
2. Ordinance Number 2066 of the City of Bixby, Oklahoma was adopted by the City Council of the City of Bixby on November 28, 2011, in accordance with laws of the state of Oklahoma.
3. Section 2 of Ordinance Number 2066 adopted the *International Residential Code for One- and Two-Family Dwellings*, 2009 Edition (IRC), together with Appendix G, as published by the International Code Council (ICC) and as amended and revised by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission.
4. The *International Residential Code for One- and Two-Family Dwellings*, 2009 Edition, together with Appendix G, as published by the ICC and as amended and revised by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission, was originally adopted by and applicable to the territory of the City of Bixby without any amendment or variation from the IRC published in the Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 748, Chapter 20, Subchapter 5, Sections 748:20-5-1, *et seq.*
5. The *International Residential Code for One- and Two-Family Dwellings*, 2009 Edition, as published by the ICC, amended and revised by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission, and adopted by City of Bixby Ordinance Number 2066 was amended by the City Council of the City of Bixby on November 13, 2012 by adoption of Ordinance Number 2097, a true and correct copy of which is submitted with this certification and, as such, shall be applicable to the territory of the City of Bixby with the following amendments:


