AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KAW CITY ADOPTING THE 2009 EDITION OF THE *INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE*, REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, QUALITY OF MATERIALS, ERECTION, INSTALLATION, ALTERATION, REPAIR, LOCATION, REPLACEMENT, ADDITION TO, USE OR MAINTENANCE OF MECHANICAL SYSTEMS IN THE CITY OF KAW CITY; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFORE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by majority vote of the City Council at a Special Meeting on the 30th day of October, 2012, it was deemed to be necessary to adopt the *International Mechanical Code*, 2009 Edition, and its appendices.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kaw City, Oklahoma, that the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Kaw City, being marked and designed as the *International Mechanical Code*, 2009 edition, including its appendices, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Mechanical Code of the City of Kaw City, in the State of Oklahoma, amending Section 5-701 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Kaw City, regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of mechanical systems as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Mechanical Code on file in the office of the City of Kaw City are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. That a new section, Section 5-702 of the Code of Ordinances will be added to read as follows, to wit:

“The following sections are hereby revised:

Section 101.1. Insert: City of Kaw City;

Section 108.4. Insert: Misdemeanor; Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00);

Section 108.5. Insert: up to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).”

Section 3. That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect

and validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The governing body hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsection, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.



ORDINANCE NO. KC 2012-10-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KAW CITY, OKLAHOMA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, ADOPTING THE 2009 EDITION OF THE *INTERNATIONAL EXISTING BUILDING CODE*, AND ADDING SUCH TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF KAW CITY, AS SECTION 5-1101, REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE REPAIR, ALTERATION, CHANGE OF OCCUPANCY, ADDITION AND RELOCATION OF EXISTING BUILDINGS, INCLUDING HISTORIC BUILDINGS, IN THE CITY OF KAW CITY; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; PROVIDING A REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by majority vote of the City Council at a Special Meeting on the 30th day of October, 2012, it was deemed to be necessary to adopt the *International Existing Building Code*, 2009 Edition, and its appendices.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kaw City, Oklahoma, that the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Kaw City, being marked and designed as the *International Existing Building Code*, 2009 edition, and its appendices, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Existing Building Code of the City of Kaw City, in the State of Oklahoma, and added to the Code of Ordinances, City of Kaw City, as Section 5-1101, for regulating and governing the repair, alteration, change of occupancy, addition and relocation of existing buildings, including historic buildings, as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Existing Building Code on file in the office of the City of Kaw City are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. That a new section, Section 5-1102 of the Code of Ordinances will be added to read as follows, to wit:

**Section 5-1102 ADDITIONS AND CHANGES TO EXISTING
BUILDING CODE**

The following sections are hereby revised:
Section 101.1 Insert: City of Kaw City;
Section 1301.2 Insert: November 1, 2012.”

Section 3. That all ordinances that are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same hereby are, repealed.

Section 4. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect



Section 2. That the following sections are hereby revised:

Section 101.1 Insert: City of Kaw City

Section 109.3 Insert: Misdemeanor; Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)

Section 111.4 Insert: up to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)





AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KAW CITY, OKLAHOMA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, ADOPTING THE 2011 EDITION OF THE *NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE*, REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING, AND AS A PRACTICAL SAFEGUARD OF PERSONS, BUILDINGS AND THEIR CONTENTS FROM THE HAZARDS OF WIRING FOR THE USE OF ELECTRICITY FOR LIGHT, HEAT, POWER, RADIO, SIGNALING AND OTHER PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by majority vote of the City Council at a Special Meeting on the 30th day of October, 2012, it was deemed to be necessary to adopt the *National Electrical Code*, 2011 Edition, and its appendices.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kaw City, Oklahoma, the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section 2. That previously enacted ordinances, Sections 5-301 through 5-313, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect and validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The governing body hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.



BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kaw City, Oklahoma, that the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Kaw City, being marked and designed as the *International Plumbing Code*, 2009 edition, and its appendices, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Plumbing Code of the City of Kaw City, in the State of Oklahoma, as Section 5-201 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Kaw City, regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of plumbing systems as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Plumbing Code on file in the office of the City of Kaw City are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. That a new section, Section 5-202 of the Code of Ordinances will be added to read as follows, to wit:

“The following sections are hereby revised:

Section 101.1. Insert: City of Kaw City;

Section 108.4. Insert: Misdemeanor; Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00);

Section 108.5. Insert: up to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).”

Section 3. That previously enacted ordinances, Sections 5-201 through 5-205 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Kaw City, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect and validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The governing body hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section 5. That nothing in this ordinance or in the Plumbing Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any right acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.


Section 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Kaw City, Oklahoma and the inhabitants thereof, that this Ordinance shall be put into full force and effect, and the emergency clause is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be deemed to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
