

## CITY OF MUSTANG

RESOLUTION # 15-025

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mustang, is concerned with the safety of its citizens and has adopted construction codes to aid in this endeavor; and

**WHEREAS**, 59 O.S. § 1000.20 of the State of Oklahoma Statutes established the Uniform Building Coded Commission Act and created the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission (herein "OUBCC") to establish the minimum standards for residential and commercial building codes statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oklahoma Administrative Code § 748: 15-1-2 requires proof the City of Mustang has complied with the OUBCC's directives in adopting the minimum building codes; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City of Mustang City Council that this resolution shall serve as notice to the public and to the State of Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission that the City of Mustang has formally approved the following legislation:

- (1) Ordinance No. 1081, adopting the International Building, Existing Building and One- and Two-Family Residential Codes, 2009 editions.
- (2) Ordinance No. 1082, adopting the National Electrical Code, 2011 edition.
- (3) Ordinance No. 1083, adopting the International Mechanical Code, 2009 edition.
- (4) Ordinance No. 1084, adopting the International Plumbing Code, 2009 edition.
- (5) Ordinance No. 1085, adopting the International Fuel gas Code, 2009 edition.
- (6) Ordinance No. 1086, adopting the International Fire Code, 2009 edition.
