## PLS Education Requirements - Reminder

This Information Is Critical to the future PLS Licensees of the Board. Because of its importance, it is being reprinted from the last edition of the Board's Buletin. Please help future Professional Land Surveyors by sharing this information.

As we have been publicizing since our statute changed in 2005, education requirements for licensure as a PLS are changing. Those changes are summarized in the **5 Paths to Licensure** flow chart shown on the opposite page. Since Long Established Practice (LEP) will no longer be a path to licensure after July 1, 2014, the Board is encouraging those on the path to licensure, regardless of where they are right now, to be familiar with this flow chart. Furthermore, the Board strongly encourages poten-

# Critical Facts About Licensure as a PLS Under Long Established Practice


- √ April 2014-is the last date to take the PS and/or OLS if admitted under LEP (See Path #5 on opposite page)
- √ If the applicant has not met all of the requirements for licensure by July 2014, he/she will have to reapply with proof of sufficient education to qualify. (see Paths #1-#4 on opposite page)
- √ If you plan to qualify for PLS licensure under LEP, apply just as soon as you get 9 years of experience so you can begin the exam process!

Even those who will qualify for the exams by LEP are encouraged to start taking land surveying classes now. For the most part, the surveying exams are based on knowledge obtained in college level land surveying class work. Taking college classes, particularly those included in the Core Curriculum, will improve the applicant's chance of success on the examinations and improve the chance of success in their surveying practice. Furthermore, a LEP applicant who does not complete all of the examinations prior to the April 2014 deadline will be that much closer to qualifying for licensure by an education pathway.

# #5 LONG ESTABLISHED PRACTICE (LEP) - NO LONGER IN EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 2014 9 YRS EXPERIENCE - FS EXAM, - PS AND OLS EXAM

the applicant's application was approved by the Board prior to July 1, 2014. Anyone approved by the Board to pursue licensure under this IMPORTANT - PLEASE NOTE: No examination shall be administered following July 1, 2014 for applicants applying under LEP even if provision must pass all examinations prior to July 1, 2014 to qualify for licensure. Otherwise to continue to pursue licensure they will be required to file a new application and qualify under the new law (See #1 - #4 above).

## DISCIPLINARY ACTIVITY OF THE BOARD

## January 21 - 22, 2010

In the Matter of Classic Country Land, L.L.C.; Case No. 2009-050; Through Consent: For offering and practicing land surveying without a Certificate of Authorization, Classic Country Land, L.L.C. is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$6,000.00, ordered to remove any and all representations on its web site "that the lots have been staked and property corners have been marked", and it is further ordered that Classic Country Land, L.L.C. provide the Board with a comprehensive list of names and address of all purchasers of parcels/lots of the six Oklahoma properties and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from offering and/or practicing land surveying in Oklahoma until such time as it has been issued a Certificate of Authorization.

In the Matter of E.D. Hill and Associates, Inc, CA 4951 and Randy King Hill; Case No. 2009-065; Through Consent: For aiding and assisting Randy King Hill in offering and/or practicing land surveying without a Certificate of Licensure, for issuing a final plat without a properly dated signature and seal and for fraud and misrepresentation, E.D. Hill and Associates, Inc. is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$2,100.00 and is hereby Reprimanded. For offering and practicing land surveying without a Certificate of Licensure, Randy King Hill is found Guilty, issued a formal Letter of Caution and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from offering and/or practicing land surveying in the State of Oklahoma until such time as he has been issued a Certificate of Licensure.

In the Matter of Isch & Associates, Inc., CA 1139 and G. Earnest Isch, P.E. 6606 (Inactive) and P.L.S. 54 (Inactive); Case No. 2009-093; Through Consent: For offering and practicing engineering in the State of Oklahoma with an expired Certificate of Licensure, G. Earnest Isch is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$5,000.00, ordered to complete the Intermediate Studies in Engineering Ethics at the College of Engineering at Texas Tech University and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from offering and/or practicing engineering until such time as he is re-licensed. For aiding and assisting G. Earnest Isch in offering and practicing engineering without a Certificate of Licensure, Isch & Associates, Inc. is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$5,000.00 and is hereby Reprimanded.

In the Matter of HK & S Iron Company; Case No. 2009-105; Through Consent: For offering engineering services in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Authorization, HK & S Iron Company is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$3,750.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from offering and/or practicing engineering until such time as it has been issued a CA.

In the Matter of Roy Lee Brown, P.E. 21336; Case No. 2009-110; Through Consent: For violations of the laws of Alabama, which are the same or substantially equivalent to the statutes and rules of Oklahoma, Roy Lee Brown is found **Guilty** and is hereby Reprimanded.

In the Matter of Xavier Chapa Engineering and Xavier Chapa; Case No. 2009-076; Through Final Order: For offering engineering services in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Authorization, Xavier Chapa Engineering is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$1,000.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from offering and/or practicing engineering until such time as it has been issued a Certificate of Authorization. For offering and/or performing engineering services in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Licensure, Xavier Chapa is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$1,000.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from holding himself out as someone having the qualifications to offer or perform engineering services in the State of Oklahoma until such time as he has been issued a Certificate of Licensure.

In the Matter of John Gregory Piazza, P.E. 18994; Case No. 2009-107; Through Consent: For fraud, deception or misrepresentation in renewing his Certificate of Licensure, John Gregory Piazza is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$2,000.00 and is ordered to complete the on-line Intermediate Studies in Engineering Ethics at the College of Engineering at Texas Tech University.

In the Matter of Tv Justus Hagen; Case No. 2009-109; Through Consent: For offering to perform engineering services in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Licensure, Ty Justus Hagen is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$750.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from offering to provide engineering services in the State of Oklahoma until such time as he has been issued a Certificate of Licensure.

In the Matter of Cape, Inc. and Bill Frederick; Case No. 2009-118; Through Consent: For offering and practicing engineering in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Authorization, Cape, Inc. is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$750.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in the State of Oklahoma until such time as it has been issued a Certificate of Authorization. For offering and practicing engineering services in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Licensure, Bill Frederick is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$750.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in the State of Oklahoma until such time as he has been issued a Certificate of Licensure.

In the Matter of Miller-McCoy, Inc., CA 1518 (I) and Richard Wayne McCoy, P.E. 15442 (I); Case No. 2009-129; Through Consent: For offering and practicing engineering in the State of Oklahoma without a Certificate of Authorization, Miller-McCoy, Inc. is found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$750.00 and is hereby ordered to Cease and Desist from practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in the State of Oklahoma until such time as it has been issued a Certificate of Authorization. ## THE PATH TO COMPLIANCE

## Unlicensed Practice and **Certified Corner Record Update**

s you might expect in a struggling economy where engineering and surveying projects are scarce, the number of out-of-state engineers and surveyors pursuing those projects has increased dramatically this year. Typically a fairly high percentage of out-of-state applications this office receives indicate that the applicant and/or firm has already either offered or begun practicing before the license has been issued. This Board has taken a very clear and consistent position that this practice is a serious violation of our law and is vigorously prosecuted. Our licensees and firms who are diligent about following the laws and rules demand this office maintain a level playing field that is fair to all.

Therefore, we have been pleasantly surprised this year because of the very high percentage of these new applications that disclose the applicant has not already offered to or actually started practicing. This is a significant change especially considering the volume of new applications we have received. This office optimistically views this change as a positive sign that efforts on our website and in our publications and presentations are effectively educating licensees and future licensees about our laws and rules. We know however, that the most effective method to combat unlicensed practice is our licensees becoming involved and insisting that governmental and private entities use individuals and firms that are properly licensed in Oklahoma and practicing within our law. This Board recognizes that there are still non-licensed practice violations and is therefore still investigating and, where warranted, prosecuting any individual or any firm who is not properly licensed in Oklahoma.

The Instruction Manual for Oklahoma Certified Corner Records published by this office and posted on our website is being updated to reflect changes by the State Department of Libraries and the Bureau of Land Management. As most Oklahoma surveyors already know, the State Department of Libraries has passed rules that will require a \$5.00 filing fee for Certified Corner Records effective July 1, 2010. Therefore, it will be more important than ever for surveyors to submit complete and accurate CCR forms in their initial submittal to the Library. Surveyors need to be aware that in 2009 the BLM updated and published its Manual of Surveying Instructions. Among the many revisions is a new definition of obliterated corners and a lengthy section on the identification and evidence of obliterated corners. Our research indicates a number of surveyors who are still not including adequate information on CCR forms about supporting evidence for monuments found and set. Simply stating that a monument was found in the vicinity of a public land survey corner is not adequate. There are too many situations where a non-licensed individual sets a nail or other temporary object for control for an engineering, topo or GIS project and then leaves it there after the project is done. Even surveyors have been known to set temporary points and then failed to pick them up. The description of what evidence was used to support a monument location is vitally important in order to verify the correctness of the location and must be included.

The statute and rules regulating the practice of engineering and surveying continue to be updated to reflect the changes in the professions. This Board publishes the current rules on its website and will continue to rely on its licensees to know the rules and help educate others.

## License Expirations

**EXPIRATION/REVOCATION -** Licenses may be revoked by the Board for non-payment of renewal fees. Licensees will be notified of revocation by certified mail. Typically this notification is mailed 10 days following expiration.

**RENEWALS** - Each license issued by the Board expires on the last day of the month in which renewal fees are due, and becomes invalid on that date unless paid. One notice of the renewal is sent by first class mail to the address of record in the board files. This in effect provides notice two months prior to revocation.

**REINSTATEMENT** - Former licensees whose certificates have expired and were revoked for failure to pay renewal fees and desire to reinstate shall make application for reinstatement within 180 days after expiration and pay the prescribed renewal fee and penalty. After 180 days, a new application will be required, which shall be considered specifically by the Board, both from the standpoint of competency and of character.

## RETIRED STATUS NOW AVAILABLE FOR PE'S AND PLS'

PE's and PLS' who wish to retire their license may do so at the time of renewal. Go to the online renewal system at www.pelsrenewal.ok.gov as if you were going to renew your license and follow the directions to retire your license - or you may contact tparr@pels.ok.gov for paper forms. There are no age restrictions, but your license must be in good standing with the Board to qualify and your license will be considered inactive. You will continue to receive the newsletter, and you will receive a wallet card with the date of the retirement of your license, and you will be able to use the title "Professional Engineer - Retired" or "Professional Land Surveyor - Retired" as applicable.

OAC 245:15-7-1(c) Certificate of Licensure states, "When a professional engineer or land surveyor in good standing desires to retire his or her license, he or she may do so upon application to the Board, subject to reinstatement and continuing education requirements by the Board."

OAC 245:15-7-5(a) Reinstatement of revoked or retired licenses states, "Licenses ......that were voluntarily retired by the licensee may be reinstated by making written application for reinstatement within 180 days after expiration and payment of the prescribed renewal fee and penalty. .... Practicing your profession with a revoked or retired license during this reinstatement period is a violation of Title 59, Section 475.1 et seq and the Rules of this Board."

OAC 245:15-11-3(4) Continuing Education - Scope and exemptions states, "A licensee who elects to choose Retired status at the time of renewal shall be exempt. In the event such person elects to return to active practice of professional engineering or surveying, 30 PDH's must be earned before returning to active practice.
