If you have taken the PE examination fewer than three (3) times on your current application, you may register with NCEES to retake the exam. Please note that it is your responsibility to register with NCEES to reserve your seat for the exam. Registration for the paper-and-pencil April 17, 2020 PE examination is currently open and will close at 2:00 pm CST on February 20, 2020. No late registrations are allowed by NCEES.

The **PE Chemical and Environmental** examinations have transitioned to a **computer-based format**. These exams may be taken year-round at NCEES approved Pearson VUE test centers.

Additionally, the **PE Petroleum, Fire Protection, and Industrial and Systems** examinations have transitioned to a computer-based format. The 2020 computer-based PE Petroleum, Fire Protection, and Industrial and Systems exams are scheduled to be offered at NCEES approved Pearson VUE test centers on **October 22, 2020**. Approved examinees are encouraged to reserve their seat for this single-day event as early as possible.

The **PE Mechanical** examination is scheduled to transition to a computer-based format in 2020. Registration is currently open, and the first testing opportunities will be available beginning in April 2020.

If you have not passed the PE examination within five (5) years of the initial approval date of your application, the application will be closed and a new application will be required in order for you to be approved for additional examination attempts. Further, if you have three (3) unsuccessful PE examination attempts authorized by this application, your application will be closed.
