General Counsel John Wolf announced the members in attendance as Allen McCall, Larry Morris, Robert Gilliland, Kelly Doyle, and Adam Luck. During the business meeting, the voting order was announced as Allen McCall, Larry Morris, Kelly Doyle, Adam Luck, and Robert Gilliland. A quorum was present.

III. Discussion and Possible Action on Jacket Review: Commutations, S.I.R. Stage I, Parole, Parole Stage I, Reentry, Medicals, and Special Reviews – Acting Chairman Allen McCall

The Board took action on inmates who were docketed for jacket review for Stage I commutations and Stage I parole considerations. Allen McCall, Larry Morris, Kelly Doyle, Adam Luck, and Robert Gilliland voted in favor of the motion. There were no votes against the motion. The motion passed. The ballot for each inmate is available for reproduction at the Administrative office of the Pardon and Parole Board in accordance with the Open Records Act.

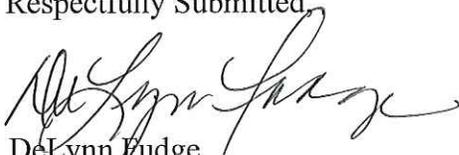
XVIII. New Business Not Known or Which Could Not Have Been Reasonably Foreseen Before the Posting of the Agenda – Acting Chairman Allen McCall
