MINUTES OF THE OPEN MEETING OF THE BOARD
April 21, 2012

An open meeting of the Board of Examiners of Psychologists was held at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 21, 2012 at the Veterinary/Dental Board, 201 NE 38th Terrace, Suite 1 & 2, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. In attendance were R. Hand, Ph.D., Chair of the Board; P. Fischer, Ph.D., Vice-Chair of the Board; M. Cohn, Ph.D.; S. Beasley, Ph.D.; S. Turner, member of the Board; T. Vaughn, Ph.D., Director of Professional Affairs; T. Rose, Executive Officer; A. East, Administrative Assistant and M. Lane, Assistant Attorney General.

Dr. Hand announced that a quorum was present to conduct business. He confirmed with Ms. Rose that the meeting was filed with the Secretary of State and the agenda was posted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act.

The motion was made by Dr. Fischer and seconded by Dr. Beasley to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2012 open meeting of the Board. The motion passed. Turner, Beasley, Cohn, Fischer and Hand voted for the motion to approve the March 16, 2012 minutes.

The motion was made by Dr. Fischer and seconded by Dr. Beasley to approve the minutes of the March 17, 2012 open meeting of the Board. The motion passed. Turner, Beasley, Cohn, Fischer and Hand voted for the motion to approve the March 17, 2012 minutes.

Ms. Rose reported that RFI 11-7 and 11-8 are being processed.

In the matter of RFI 12-4, Ms. Lane reported that the inquiry is being processed.

In the matter of RFI 12-5, Ms. Rose reported that the procedures for an inquiry are beginning.

Ms. Lane reported on RFI 11-3. A Probable Cause Committee meeting occurred with Dr. Cochran, Dr. Schaefer, Ms. Lane and the psychologist. The Probable Cause Committee determined there was evidence of ethical violations and cited concerns of APA Ethical Principles Sections 3.05(a), 3.06, 3.10(a, b & d), 6.01, 9.01(a & b), 10.02 and ASPPB Code of Conduct Sections III (A) 6; 7(a) 1, 2, 5, 6 & 7; (B) 2(a); (F) 3 & 5; (J) 1 and

HIPAA violations. The committee recommended that the Board file a formal Board complaint. Dr. Beasley made a motion to accept the Probable Cause Committee's recommendation for RFI 11-3 to file a formal complaint. Mr. Turner seconded the motion and the motion passed. Turner, Beasley, Cohn and Fischer voted for the motion to accept the Probable Cause Committee's recommendation for RFI 11-3 to file a formal Board complaint. Dr. Hand recused from the vote. The Board also discussed setting a hearing date for the complaint of July 20, 2012.

Dr. Hand reported on RFI 12-1. An informal meeting took place between Dr. Hand, Dr. Vaughn, Ms. Lane and the psychologist. Dr. Beasley made a motion to accept the recommendation of the informal meeting attendees to dismiss and close RFI 12-1 with no ethical violation. Dr. Cohn seconded the motion and the motion passed. Turner, Beasley, Cohn, Fischer and Hand voted for the motion to accept the recommendation of the informal meeting attendees to dismiss and close RFI 12-1 with no ethical violation.

The Board reviewed the revised consent order for BC 09-8 against Dr. Reynolds. Dr. Cohn made a motion to approve the consent order as presented in the case of BC 09-8. Dr. Fischer seconded the motion and the motion passed. Turner, Beasley, Cohn, Fischer and Hand voted for the motion to accept the consent order as presented in the case of BC 09-8.

In the matter of BC 10-1 against Dr. Harpole, no report is due at this time. The matter will be reported on at the May 18, 2012 meeting.

In the matter of BC 10-2, the Board reviewed Dr. Coyle's clientele list. Dr. Beasley made a motion to accept Dr. Coyle's clientele list and request additions of columns for active confirmation that each matter is not a forensic matter or custody visitation matter and report termination of any client relationship and reason for termination for future reports. Mr. Turner seconded the motion and the motion passed. Ms. Rose reported on RFI 11-1 against Dr. Russell. Dr. Russell is in full compliance with the Board.

Ms. Lane reported on BC 11-5 against Dr. Hartsell. A hearing date is set for May 18. Ms. Lane and the counsel for Dr. Hartsell are working towards an agreed consent order.

Dr. Vaughn reported on Requests for Inquiry that have been received from the Department of Corrections. The Board tasked Ms. Lane with investigating what avenues are in place for complaints from the Department of Corrections.

The Board reviewed the request for Continuing Professional Education for "Enneagram and Addiction", sponsored by Solutions Outpatient Services for 6 credit hours on May 8, 2012. Dr. Beasley made a motion to deny the continuing education workshop "Enneagram and Addiction" because it does not appear to have a primarily psychologist audience. Dr. Fischer seconded the motion and the motion passed. Turner, Beasley, Cohn, Fischer and Hand voted for the motion to deny the continuing education workshop "Enneagram and Addiction" because it does not appear to have a primarily psychologist audience.

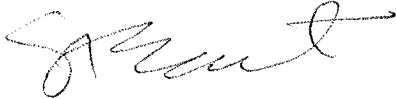
Ms. Rose reported on the PLUS applications.
