

DEFINITIONS

“State/Tribal” - means certain tribal locations on trust land owned or licensed by Federally Recognized Indian Tribes or Nations, which signed compacts with the State of Oklahoma regarding cigarette and tobacco products after July 1, 2008.

“State/Tribal Border” - means certain tribal locations or trust land owned or licensed by Federally Recognized Indian Tribes or Nations which signed compacts with the State of Oklahoma regarding cigarette and tobacco that are within 20 miles of either the Kansas or Missouri border after July 1, 2008.

“Unity Rate” means Compacts entered into between the State and Native American Tribes and Nations effective on or after August 24, 2012, providing for payment of a State reduced cigarette excise tax and Tribal tax, evidenced by a joint Unity Rate tax stamp.
