
Important Dates:

 - **Treasurer Sends Tax Bills**




Important Dates:

- December 31:
 - **First Half of Tax Due**
- April 1:
 - **Second Half of Tax Due**



CBOE Extension, Special Session:

- All Counties A. G. Op. 00-23
- Notice By May 15
- For Pending Protests Only
- Until July 31
- Extends Hearing Period Only
- No Relief For Protests Filed After May 31
- No Extension of Filing Period



Sending Notices:

- Calendar to Working Days
 - Anyone Can File A Protest Before May 1
- 29 Calendar Days For Informal
- Notice Of Informal Decision
 - 41 To 48 Calendar Days
- Protest To CBOE
 - 53 To 60 Calendar Days



Sending Notices:

- Notice Of CBOE Decision
 - 58 To 65 Calendar Days
- When To Mail
 - 65 Calendar Days From The Initial
 - Mail Notices Last Week In March
