AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ADA, OKLAHOMA, ANNEXING AN AREA ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF ADA INTO AND AS A PART OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY OF ADA, AS SAID ANNEXATION IS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR ZONING; DIRECTING FILING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a written request has been presented to the City Council of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, signed by the owners of at least a majority of the acres proposed to be annexed, requesting consideration, approval and passage of an ordinance extending and annexing into the corporate limits of the City of Ada certain real property adjacent or contiguous to the city limits of the City of Ada, as provided under the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Ada, and the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and said Council, after hearing the facts and being sufficiently advised, is of the opinion that all requirements necessary for the annexation of said property into the City of Ada, and to extend the corporate limits thereof, have been complied with as provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Ada, and the laws of the State of Oklahoma as set forth in Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, Section 21-101, *et seq.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. ANNEXED AREA.

That the following described real property shall become attached to and be within the corporate limits of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, and shall hereafter be considered an integral part of the corporate limits, and said corporate limits of the City of Ada, Oklahoma, are extended and enlarged so as to include all of the property described as follows, to-wit:

A part of the N/2 of SW/4 of Section 3, Township 3 North, Range 6 East, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of said N/2 of SW/4, said point being 1,241.9 feet West of the Southeast corner of said N/2 of SW/4; thence N 89°58'54" W along said South line a distance of 778.19 feet to a point on the South line of the abandoned O.C.A.&A Railroad right-of-way; thence N 69°27'20" W along said right-of-way line a distance of 295.63 feet to the P.C. of curve; thence Northwesterly along said right-of-way line on a curve to the right having a radius of 1,984.86 feet a distance of 197.74 feet to a point on the East right-of-way line of Kerr Lab Road; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line on a curve to the right having a

radius of 2,764.79 feet a distance of 487.15 feet; thence N 14°17'20" E along said right-of-way line a distance of 98.90 feet; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line on a curve to the right having a radius of 2,784.79 feet a distance of 264.20 feet to a point 362.71 feet South of the North line of said N/2 of SW/4; thence S 89°56'43" E and parallel with the North line of said N/2 of SW/4 a distance of 918.48 feet to a point 362.71 feet South and 80.15 feet East of the 1/16th corner of the North side of the SW/4 of said Section 3; thence S 00°10'11" W a distance of 964.37 feet to the point of beginning, containing 23.98 acres, more or less.

Together with all that part of the right-of-way of Kerr Lab Road located adjacent thereto, extending from the southern boundary of the present city limits of the City of Ada, to the southern line of the abandoned O.C.A.&A. Railroad right-of-way.

All as shown on the map and plat attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

## SECTION 2. ZONING

Said property shall retain its current zoning classification.

## SECTION 3. FILING

Pursuant to *Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, §21-112*, a duly certified copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map or plat of the annexed territory, shall be filed:

- A. In the office of the County Clerk of Pontotoc County, Oklahoma.
- B. With the Ad Valorem Division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission.


## SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE


